Great Success of the “Madrid 2003 Global IPv6 Summit” Coexistence of IPv6, PLC and WLAN

Madrid, June 16th 2003 – Right one month after the past Madrid 2003 Global IPv6 Summit, the success has been confirmed by the delegates.

The attendees have confirmed an average scoring of 5 over 6, and over 80 Gigabytes of information (including videos available at the documents section) have been downloaded from the event web site (<http://www.ipv6-es.com>), with more than 30.000 unique visits.

In addition to the daily 330 attendees present in the hall of the Hotel Auditorium, over 1.300 connected to the streaming server, meaning an overall participation superior to any previous event of the IPv6 Forum.

One of several remarkable demonstrations was the PLC connectivity provided at the conference venue by the 6POWER project. The power grid of the hotel facilitated the distribution of several WLAN access points in locations not accessible by means of regular network wiring, enabling a better wireless coverage, for both IPv4 and IPv6.

For this installation, the first results of the 45 Mbps technology, with IPv6 and QoS support had been applied, thus enabling the delivery of video streaming for the delegates.

The next Global IPv6 Summit will be held in San Diego (USA) from 24th to 27th of June, where the latest information about the adoption of IPv6 by the Department of Defense,

starting next October, will be made public. More information available at <http://www.usipv6.com>.
